

The *Secondary Mathematics Education Program* is one option in the College of Science BA or BS degree in Mathematics. This option is intended to prepare students to be secondary school mathematics teachers. Students who complete this option will be certified by The Arizona Department of Education as having fulfilled a teacher preparation degree program. The Education Option has two components, a set of *courses in Mathematics* and a set of *courses in Teaching and Learning Mathematics*. The *courses in Teaching and Learning Mathematics* replace the requirement for the minor, although students are encouraged to pursue another area as a minor.
