Minimum units required: 18 (at least 3 units must be completed at UA)

Minimum upper-division units required: 6

Minimum minor GPA: 2.00

 - MATH 122A/B or 125: Calculus I
 - MATH 129: Calculus II
 - MATH 205: Teaching Secondary Mathematics
 - MATH 313: Introduction to Linear Algebra (formerly MATH 215)
 - MATH 406A*: Curriculum & Assessment in Secondary School Mathematics
- Elective – choose one to complete (3-4 units):
 - MATH 315: Introduction to Number Theory and Modern Algebra
 - MATH 330: Topics in Geometry
 - MATH 404: History of Mathematics
 - MATH 263: Intro to Stats & Biostats AND MATH 306[†]: Teaching Methods for Stats and Data Sci
